



WISCONSIN VETERINARY TECHNICIAN ASSOCIATION

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE 1

This organization shall be known as the Wisconsin Veterinary Technician Association.

ARTICLE 2

The period of existence shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE 3

The purposes of this organization shall be:

- a. To promote professionalism and ethical behavior of all veterinary technicians;
- b. To promote continuing educational opportunities for veterinary technicians;
- c. To improve and encourage communication among veterinary technicians;
- d. To inform and represent veterinary technicians in legislative matters;
- e. To inform the veterinary profession as to the value and benefits derived from employing trained para-professionals;
- f. To improve and support the development of the veterinary technician vocation;
- g. To assist in providing the best medical attention available to suffering animals; and
- h. To promote the humane treatment of animals.

ARTICLE 4

The number of officers shall be fixed by the by-laws but shall not be less than three.

ARTICLE 5

The designation of classes of members and their qualifications and rights shall be set forth in the bylaws.

ARTICLE 6

These articles may be amended in the manner authorized by the bylaws at time of the amendment.

ARTICLE 7

These articles supersede and take the place of all previously existing articles of the constitution and amendments thereto.
